



INTERNATIONAL MODEL A DAY

A number of Model "A" Ford owners around the world have come together and declared Saturday, July 26, 2008 as INTERNATIONAL MODEL "A" DAY. This first year is coincidental with the eightieth year of the Model "A" Ford's first model in 1928. There is a contingency plan for a local rain event date of Sunday, July 27.
